



RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROCUREMENT OF PROTECTION SHELTER/SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS INCLUDING DISINFECTION TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE EMPLOYEES AND GUESTS IN THE WORKPLACE DUE TO COVID-19 IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP3,305,500.00) THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-EMERGENCY CASES UNDER SECTION 53.2 OF RA 9182 AND ITS 2016 REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the President through Proclamation No. 922 has declared a State of Public Health Emergency in the entire Philippines in order to mobilize the governmental and non-governmental agencies to respond to the threats brought by the CoVid-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, this temporarily limited the operation of various government offices in order to comply with the imposed minimum health standards including the observance of physical distancing in the workplace;
