REQUEST TO SUBMIT PROPOSAL FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF DA GUEST HOUSE UNDER 2023 CORN PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION AT APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNTING TO SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP700,000.00) PURSUANT TO ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT SPECIFICALLY NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.9 UNDER RA 9184 AND ITS REVISED IRR.

The Department of Agriculture Regional Field Office No. 5 (DA RFO 5), San Agustin, Pili, Camarines Sur is inviting interested suppliers to submit complete bid proposal for the Labor and Materials for the Improvement of DA Guest House under 2023 Corn Program Implementation. The agency intends to apply the amount *Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php700,000.00)* as the Approved Budget for the Contract.
